Members have a special entry system. Your membership card has a barcode which should be scanned at the computer opposite the Ticket Office and this allows you speedy entry, avoiding the queues. *Please look out for special messages just for you too!*

Conditions

Membership card is for a named person's use only and is not transferrable.

Safety of children

Children must be supervised at all times – the ponds are deep and the grounds are uneven with hidden drops.

Please keep children away from garden machinery. It is dangerous to touch, particularly if moving.

Please respect the spirituality of the Great Church and Lady Chapel and do not run around in these areas, climb or move gravel.

Don't allow children to play with the displays in the museum and the Abbot's Kitchen. Child friendly activities are available and unsupervised youngsters will not be allowed into the kitchen or museum.

Do not climb on any part of the ruins – not only is it unsafe for you and your family it also damages the monument.

Bicycles, scooters or skateboards, playing with a Frisbee or ball games are not allowed.

For your enjoyment

Do picnic in the grounds or stop for a tea or coffee. However, the Great Church and Lady Chapel are important spiritual places so please do not picnic in these areas and do take your rubbish home.

At all times please be respectful of the religious nature of the site, cover up appropriately and do not sit, stand or lie down on the altars.

Ceremonies of any sort are not allowed without prior permission of the director. For more information, please ask.

Dogs are welcome but please keep them on short leads and do use our poop bins!

We have a thriving wildlife area so please be aware badgers are active on the site, which contributes to the uneven ground, and they can leave behind smelly deposits!

And finally... staff can assist you if you have any difficulties. If you see someone not following our guidelines do report it.

Anyone found repeatedly ignoring the conditions of entry will be asked to leave or have a membership revoked as part of the terms and conditions for membership at the abbey.
